### **Labor & Immigration March Returns to Downtown City Restricts Street/Lane Closures in Affected Area**

On Thursday, May 1, 2008, thousands of people are expected to converge on downtown Los Angeles to participate in an annual Labor and Immigration March and Rally.

The L.A.P.D. Special Events Unit has directed that no lane and street closures be approved along the march route and within designated congregating areas. Because these areas encompass a sizable portion of downtown, FilmL.A. has outlined the event perimeter below for your use:

- Route:** 7<sup>th</sup> Street Between Alvarado St. and Figueroa St.  
(Closed 12:30 PM to 4:00 PM)
- Area 1:** Cesar Chavez Ave. to the North (Closed 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM)  
Los Angeles St. to the East  
Venice Blvd. to the South  
Harbor Fwy. to the West (I-110)
- Area 2:** 6<sup>th</sup> St. to the North (Closed 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM)  
Alvarado St. to the East  
8<sup>th</sup> St. to the South  
Hoover St. to the West
